

Senate Bill 103

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to powers of local governments as to air facilities, so as to provide that airports
3 owned, controlled, or operated by a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of
4 this state shall not assess any fee to a veteran for motor vehicle parking; to provide for a
5 definition; to provide for exceptions; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
6 laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
10 powers of local governments as to air facilities, is amended by adding a new Code section
11 to read as follows:

12 "6-3-29.

13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'veteran' means a former member of the armed
14 forces of the United States who is discharged from the armed forces under conditions other
15 than dishonorable.

16 (b) No facilities used in connection with landing fields for the use of aircraft and that are
17 owned, controlled, or operated by a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of
18 this state shall assess any fee to a veteran for the use of such facilities to park such veteran's
19 motor vehicle while such veteran is making use of such facilities; provided, however, that
20 this subsection shall not apply:

21 (1) To more than one motor vehicle;

22 (2) If parking for a flight to and from a destination exceeds 14 days; or

23 (3) If parking for any reason, other than that provided for under paragraph (2) of this
24 subsection, exceeds 24 consecutive hours."

SECTION 2.

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
