

The Senate Committee on Higher Education offered the following substitute to SB 91:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 20-3-250.3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 educational institutions exempted from application of part relative to nonpublic
3 postsecondary educational institutions, so as to provide for an exemption for orthodontic
4 schools meeting certain criteria; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

7 Code Section 20-3-250.3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to educational
8 institutions exempted from application of part relative to nonpublic postsecondary
9 educational institutions, is amended by revising paragraph (13) of subsection (a) as follows:

10 “(13) Subject to the requirements of subsection (c) of Code Section 20-3-250.6, any
11 nonpublic medical school accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education
12 and a national or regional accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department
13 of Education or orthodontic residency school and education program accredited by the
14 Commission on Dental Accreditation and a national accrediting agency recognized by the
15 Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services; and”

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
