A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and recognizing Sharon Stovall Daniel; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Sharon Stovall Daniel is an agent of dynamic change in business, community,
3 and politics; in 1986, she cofounded Stovall Enterprises, Inc., now Stovall's T-Shirts, which
4 is a retail merchandising firm; and

5 WHEREAS, Stovall's T-Shirts managed stadium retail operations for the 1996 Olympic
6 Games, two Super Bowls, the Atlanta Falcons, SEC Championships, Chick-Fil-A Peach
7 Bowl, the Atlanta Hawks, Motorsport Events, various concerts, Sanford Stadium at the
8 University of Georgia, Coca-Cola/Lakewood Amphitheater, Atlanta Fulton County Stadium,
9 and has managed several promotional printing locations throughout Metro Atlanta; and

10 WHEREAS, Sharon has managed and consulted on local and state level political campaigns,
11 and she led the charge for legislative efforts, including education reform and economic
12 development; she cofounded the Morrow Community Fall Festival, which drew over 5,000
13 attendees to this unity in the community event; and

14 WHEREAS, she is a staunch parent advocate and serves as a five-time president for several
15 parental organizations, including PTA, school council, and various booster clubs; Sharon has
16 conceptualized and produced community engagements, which have positively impacted over
17 1,000 families in the Atlanta and Clayton County Areas through food drives, which have fed
18 over 600 families, and the Atlanta Senior Citizens Coalition, which engages seniors as policy
19 advocates; and

20 WHEREAS, Sharon served as Governance Board Chair of the first Georgia Commission
21 Charter School in 2014, where she was a prominent leader in the statewide advocacy
22 campaign for the legislative-approved Charter School Fairness Act; in 2017, she cofounded
23 AmbitiousX Learning Center in Metro Atlanta to offer underserved high school students
24 access to authentic real world learning experiences; and

25 WHEREAS, she is currently serving as founding Governance Board Vice Chair of 7 Pillars
26 Career Academy, a newly approved charter school for grades 6 through 12; and

27 WHEREAS, Sharon resides in Clayton County, with her husband of 33 years, Carl, Sr., and
28 is the mother of three remarkable children, Shyron, Carl II, and Monica; her life motto is "it
29 takes a village to raise a child, and if it is to be, it is up to me."

31 the members of this body commend and recognize Sharon Stovall Daniel.
