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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

| 8 | of the State Victim Services Commission, is amended by revising subsections (a) and (b) as |
| 9 | follows: |
| 10 | "(a) The State Victim Services Commission shall consist of $\frac{15}{14}$ members as follows: |
| 11 | (1) The executive director of the Prosecuting Attorneys' Council of Georgia or his or her |
| 12 | designee; |
| 13 | (2) The president of the Georgia Sheriffs' Association or his or her designee; |
| 14 | (3) The executive director of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council or his or her |
| 15 | designee; |
| 16 | (4) The chairperson of the Georgia Commission on Family Violence or his or her |
| 17 | designee; |
| 18 | (5) The executive director of the Georgia Coalition Against Domestic Violence or his or |
| 19 | her designee; |
| 20 | (6) The executive director of the Association County Commissioners of Georgia or his |
| 21 | or her designee; |
| 22 | (7) The executive director of the Children's Advocacy Centers of Georgia or his or her |

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- (9) The executive director of the Georgia Association of Homes and Services for 26 27 Children or his or her designee; 28 (10)(9) The executive director of the Georgia Municipal Association or his or her 29 designee; (11)(10) The executive director of the Georgia Network to End Sexual Assault or his or 30 31 her designee; (12)(11) A district attorney appointed by the Prosecuting Attorneys' Council of Georgia; 32 (13)(12) One member appointed by the Governor; 33 34 (14)(13) One member appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; and (15)(14) One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. 35 (b) The term of appointment shall be three years for initial members appointed in 36 37 accordance with the provisions of paragraphs (13) and (15) of subsection (a) of this Code section. The term of appointment shall be two years for initial members appointed in 38 39 accordance with the provisions of paragraphs (12) and (14) of subsection (a) of this Code 40 section. The letter of appointment shall set out the term for which each member is appointed. Thereafter, each member shall be appointed for a term of two years, and no 41 42 member may serve more than two consecutive terms. All vacancies shall be filled for the 43 unexpired term by an appointee of the original appointing official."
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SECTION 2.

45 Code Section 49-5-281 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the bill of46 rights for foster parents, is amended by revising subsection (e) as follows:

47 "(e) The Department of Human Services, in consultation with the representatives of

48 Georgia Association of Homes and Services for Children and other appropriate provider

49 associations and the Adoptive and Foster Parent Association of Georgia, shall develop a

50 grievance procedure for dealing with any grievances their foster parents have in response

51 to any violation of this article, no later than July 1, 2007. The department shall enforce this

52 provision through policies and procedures and through its contracts with providers."

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SECTION 3.

54 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
