

The Senate Committee on Transportation offered the following substitute to SB 103:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to powers of local governments as to air facilities, so as to provide that airports
3 owned, controlled, or operated by a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of
4 this state shall designate and provide priority parking spaces for certain veterans; to provide
5 for definitions; to provide for compliance; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
6 laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
10 powers of local governments as to air facilities, is amended by adding a new Code section
11 to read as follows:

12 "6-3-29.

13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:

14 (1) 'Disabled veteran' means any person issued a motor vehicle license plate under Code
15 Section 40-2-68, 40-2-69, 40-2-70, 40-2-84, or 40-2-85.1 and who has such license plate
16 on the motor vehicle that he or she is operating or is a passenger therein.

17 (2) 'Parking place for persons with disabilities' shall have the same meaning as set forth
18 in Code Section 40-6-221.

19 (3) 'Priority parking spaces' means, within any area used for the parking of vehicles,
20 spaces for the parking of a vehicle that are closest in proximity to a facility open to the
21 public that is used in connection with a landing field for the use of aircraft, but that are
22 subordinate to parking places for persons with disabilities.

23 (b) Every facility used in connection with landing fields for the use of aircraft that is
24 owned, controlled, or operated by a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of
25 this state shall designate and provide at least three priority parking spaces for disabled
26 veterans.

27 (c) No person who is not a disabled veteran shall park his or her vehicle in such priority
28 parking spaces provided for under this Code section."

29 **SECTION 2.**

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
