## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Charles "Chuck" Miller; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Charles "Chuck" Miller on February 12, 2019; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller was a native of Wheeling, West Virginia. He believed in education  
5 and set an example for his family and friends in completing his education. He graduated  
6 from Howe Military Academy in Indiana, and later attended Case Institute of Technology  
7 and Ohio State University, studying engineering; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller's talents and civic contributions are evident in the structures he built.  
9 The Arlington School was not only a structure his company built, but he also served on the  
10 Board of Directors to assist in making the school, a school of excellence; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller served this great country in the United States Army, where he was  
12 stationed at Fort McPherson in East Point, where he met his beloved wife, Memy Miller, who  
13 preceded him in death; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller served the City of Chattahoochee Hills in various capacities. His  
15 commitment to his community, the city, and the state will always be remembered; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller touched the lives of so many in civic duty, in volunteering, and in  
17 business. His imprint has forever changed us and made his community, city, and state a  
18 better place to be.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Charles "Chuck" Miller.
