

The Senate Committee on State and Local Governmental Operations offered the following substitute to HB 95:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to make provisions for the Magistrate Court of Jenkins County, approved
2 March 12, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 4111), so as to provide for the appointment of deputy
3 magistrates; to provide for such appointment to be made by the county governing authority;
4 to provide terms for the chief magistrate and deputy magistrates as provided by law; to repeal
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act to make provisions for the Magistrate Court of Jenkins County, approved March 12,
9 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 4111), is amended by revising Section 1 as follows:

10 "Section 1. The number of magistrates authorized for Jenkins County shall be one chief
11 magistrate and such deputy magistrates as deemed necessary by the county governing
12 authority. The chief magistrate in office on the effective date of this Act shall serve out
13 the term for which he was appointed. Successors to said chief magistrate and any deputy
14 magistrate shall be appointed by the county governing authority for a term as provided
15 by O.C.G.A. § 15-10-20 or as otherwise provided by law."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
