

## Senate Resolution 326

## A RESOLUTION

1 Celebrating Peachtree City's 60th Anniversary; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Peachtree City was chartered March 9, 1959, after a group of real estate  
3 developers amassed more than 12,000 acres of land in Fayette County to build a strong and  
4 vibrant community for Georgian families; and

5 WHEREAS, in 1775, William McIntosh, Jr., son of a Scotsman and Creek Indian woman,  
6 was born and he later became Chief of the Lower Creek Indian Tribes that lived in the area.  
7 In honor of Chief McIntosh, many towns and roads in Fayette County were originally given  
8 Scottish names; and

9 WHEREAS, Peachtree City is the current home to more than 35,000 Georgians, including  
10 more than 1,700 business owners. A vibrant economy and outstanding quality of life are  
11 why business owners "Plan to Stay" in Peachtree City; and

12 WHEREAS, Peachtree City's convenient proximity to the world's busiest airport,  
13 Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, is a big factor in the city's corporate  
14 success; and

15 WHEREAS, Peachtree City is committed to ensuring residents a safe and healthy  
16 environment in which to work and live by promoting a sense of community through family  
17 oriented activities and citizen involvement; and

18 WHEREAS, Peachtree City has been called the "golf cart capital of the world" with more  
19 than 9,000 registered golf carts and nearly 100 miles of tar paths. On most days, hundreds  
20 of golf carts drive along the sprawling network of paths that has become known as the  
21 "children's highway"; and

22 WHEREAS, Peachtree City holds the perfect combination of a quiet and community  
23 centered life while also being in close proximity to the capital of our great state. Peachtree  
24 City has and continues to promote a high quality of life while also maintaining a friendly and  
25 safe neighborhood throughout its 60 years as one of Georgia's thriving cities.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
27 celebrate Peachtree City for its continuance as an involved and vibrant community for the  
28 past 60 years in Georgia.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
30 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the  
31 press.
