A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Georgia Section of the Institute of Transportation
2 Engineers and the Atlanta Chapter of the Women's Transportation Seminar for their
3 exceptional contributions to the advancement of the transportation industry; and for other
4 purposes.

5 WHEREAS, the Institute of Transportation Engineers is an international educational and
6 scientific association of transportation professionals who meet mobility and safety needs and
7 support the development of transportation professionals; its Georgia Section has 457
8 industrious members; and

9 WHEREAS, the Women's Transportation Seminar is an international network of 40,000
10 transportation professionals who are dedicated to the development, encouragement, and
11 recognition of women to support their advancement in transportation professions; its Atlanta
12 Chapter has 237 pioneering members; and

13 WHEREAS, both the Institute of Transportation Engineers-Georgia Section and Women's
14 Transportation Seminar-Atlanta Chapter have been named sections of the year in 2018 by
15 their international organizations; and

16 WHEREAS, the Institute of Transportation Engineers and the Women's Transportation
17 Seminar are committed professionals who are rooted in community values and are vanguards
18 of a safe transportation industry; and

19 WHEREAS, the Institute of Transportation Engineers and the Women's Transportation
20 Seminar members are active leaders within the transportation industry and enthusiastic
21 professionals who strive toward promoting diverse career opportunities in transportation; and

22 WHEREAS, the Institute of Transportation Engineers-Georgia Section and the Women's
23 Transportation Seminar-Atlanta Chapter are committed to transportation issues in Georgia

24 with their focus being the safety and efficiency of roads, sidewalks, and HOV lanes; their
25 dedication to multi-use infrastructure projects in the State; and their commitment to equity
26 and access in the transportation industry which is invaluable to Georgia; and

27 WHEREAS, the Institute of Transportation Engineers-Georgia Section and the Women's
28 Transportation Seminar-Atlanta Chapter are devoted to community service activities
29 including working with the Future City Program as well as encouraging and educating
30 Georgia's female youth to enter the field of transportation; and

31 WHEREAS, these outstanding organizations are committed to supporting the future of the
32 transportation industry by providing scholarships to future professionals; the Georgia Section
33 of the Institute of Transportation Engineers provided \$13,000 and the Atlanta Chapter of
34 Women's Transportation Seminar provided \$10,000 in scholarship funds last year; and

35 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding commitment and
36 diligence of the Institute of Transportation Engineers-Georgia Section and the Women's
37 Transportation Seminar-Atlanta Chapter be appropriately recognized.

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
39 the members of this body recognize and commend the members of the Institute of
40 Transportation Engineers-Georgia Section and the Women's Transportation Seminar-Atlanta
41 Chapter for their exceptional efforts and commitment to advancing the transportation
42 industry in Georgia.
