

Senate Bill 243

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 special license plates promoting or supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit
3 corporations, so as to establish a specialty license plate to benefit the Autism Alliance of
4 Georgia; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to provide for
5 compliance with constitutional requirements; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license
10 plates promoting or supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit corporations, is
11 amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (l) to read as follows:

12 "(58) A special license plate promoting autism awareness. The funds raised by the sale
13 of this special license plate shall be disbursed to the Autism Alliance of Georgia. Such
14 special license plate shall include the phrase 'Autism Awareness' in lieu of the name of
15 the county of issuance."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
18 without such approval.

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(n) of the
21 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the
22 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.

SECTION 4.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
