A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to extend the limits of the City of Fort Valley and for other purposes,
2 approved August 17, 1925 (Ga. L. 1925, p. 1063), so as to remove a certain geographical
3 area from the corporate limits of said city; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 An Act to extend the limits of the City of Fort Valley and for other purposes, approved
7 August 17, 1925 (Ga. L. 1925, p. 1063), is amended by adding a new section to read as
8 follows:

9 style="text-align:center">"SECTION 1A.

10 The corporate limits of the City of Fort Valley shall not include within its corporate limits
11 the following parcels:

12 (1) That portion of Georgia State Highway 96 beginning at the easterly edge of the
13 current city limits of the City of Fort Valley on said road then traveling in an easterly
14 direction 8.6 miles to the westerly edge of US Highway 41. Lying and situate in Land
15 Lots 13, 20, 45, 52, 77, 84, 109, 116, 141, 148, 173 of the 9th Land District and Land
16 Lots 4, 29, 36, 37, 38, 59, 60, 69, 70 in the 10th Land District;

17 (2) That portion of Housers Mill Road Right of Way from the northerly edge of Georgia
18 State Highway 96 then traveling north 4.2 miles to the southerly edge of the Right of
19 Way of Highway 247 Connector. Lying and situate in Land Lots 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 in the
20 10th Land District and Land Lots 14, 15, 16 in the 5th Land District;

21 (3) All that tract or parcel of land consisting of 1.845 acres lying and being in Peach
22 County, Georgia, as described at deed book 0201, page 360 recorded in the real property
23 records of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Peach County;

24 (4) All that tract or parcel of land consisting of 11.57 acres lying and being in Peach
25 County, Georgia, as described at deed book 2780, page 75 recorded in the real property
26 records of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Peach County; and

27 (5) All that tract or parcel of land consisting of 13.01 acres lying and being in Peach
28 County, Georgia, as described at deed book 591, page 675 recorded in the real property
29 records of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Peach County."

SECTION 2.

31 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
