A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding insurance, so as to create the crime of staging a collision; to
- 3 provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 4 for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 7 Chapter 1 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 8 provisions regarding insurance, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "33-1-9.1.
- 10 (a) A person shall be guilty of the crime of staging a collision when, with intent to commit
- insurance fraud, as defined in Code Section 33-1-9, such person does any of the following:
- 12 (1) Intentionally causes or attempts to cause a motor vehicle collision; or
- 13 (2) Engages in a scheme to fabricate evidence of a motor vehicle collision that did not
- 14 occur.
- 15 Staging a collision shall constitute a felony punishable by no less than one year nor more
- 16 <u>than five years imprisonment.</u>
- 17 (b) A person shall be guilty of the crime of aggravated staging of a collision when, with
- 18 <u>intent to commit insurance fraud as defined in Code Section 33-1-9, such person commits</u>
- 19 acts in violation of subsection (a) of this Code section which result in serious personal
- 20 <u>injury to another</u>. Aggravated staging of a collision shall constitute a felony punishable by
- 21 <u>no less than two years nor more than ten years imprisonment.</u>
- 22 (c) A person shall be guilty of the crime of making a fraudulent claim related to a staged
- 23 <u>collision when such person makes, or assists in making, a claim for insurance benefits of</u>
- 24 <u>any type or brings, or assists in bringing, a civil lawsuit against another seeking monetary</u>
- 25 <u>damages with knowledge that the injuries for which insurance benefits or monetary</u>
- 26 <u>damages are sought resulted from a staged collision, or seeks to obtain any benefit to which</u>

- 28 collision shall constitute a felony and shall be punishable by no less than one year nor more
- 29 than five years imprisonment."

30 SECTION 2.

- 31 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 32 without such approval.

33 SECTION 3.

34 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
