

Senators Harper of the 7th, Henson of the 41st, Jordan of the 6th, Miller of the 49th, Ligon, Jr. of the 3rd and others offered the following amendment:

ADOPTED

1 *Amend HB 392 (LC 41 1823) by replacing lines 1 through 4 with the following:*

2 To amend Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to public officers and
3 employees, so as to provide expense allowance and travel cost reimbursement for members
4 of the Board of Public Safety; to revise duties of the Secretary of State; to

5 *By replacing lines 8 through 10 with the following:*

6 Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to public officers and employees,
7 is amended in Code Section 45-7-21, relating to expense allowance and travel cost
8 reimbursement for members of certain boards and commissions, by revising subsection (a)
9 as follows:

10 *By inserting between lines 44 and 45 the following:*

11 Said title is further amended in Code Section 45-13-20, relating to duties of Secretary of
12 State generally, by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

13 "(14.1) To promulgate a regulation that establishes security protocols for voter
14 registration information maintained and developed by the Secretary of State pursuant to
15 Code Section 21-2-211 and 52 U.S.C. Section 21083. The regulation shall be generally
16 consistent with current industry security standards, and in promulgating the regulation,
17 the Secretary of State shall consider those security standards issued by the National
18 Institute of Standards and Technology, the Center for Internet Security, and the federal
19 Election Assistance Commission. The Secretary of State shall, at least annually, certify
20 that the State of Georgia has substantially complied with the requirements of the
21 regulation promulgated pursuant to this Code section;"
