- 1 To amend Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sales

- 3 to provide for an annual report; provide for an exemption for charges related to memberships
- 4 in certain clubs or organizations; to provide for related matters; to provide for sunset; to

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
- 9 sales and use tax, is amended by revising paragraphs (46) and (90) as follows:
- 10 "(46) For the period beginning July 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2025, sales Sales
- to blood banks <u>and organ procurement organizations as defined in Code Section 44-5-141</u>
- having a nonprofit status pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- 13 <u>Each organ procurement organization exempt under this paragraph shall submit an annual</u>
- 14 report to the Department of Community Health which includes the number of donors and
- transplants facilitated by such organization in the organization's previous fiscal year;"
- 16 "(90) Charges for initiation in and membership to a club or organization if such
- 17 <u>membership provides the purchaser with the right to access for a term of one year or more</u>
- a facility that is designed primarily for the enhancement of physical fitness or shooting
- sports and is operated by such club or organization Reserved;"

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
