A RESOLUTION

21 of the positive effect law enforcement professionals have on the lives and well-being of
22 others; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that gratitude is expressed for the unique and
24 often unheralded contributions of law enforcement professionals on behalf of the citizens of
25 this state.
