## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the United States Congress to oppose the Green New Deal; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Green New Deal was recently introduced in Congress; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the Green New Deal would turn the American economy upside down,  
4 dramatically expand government, and substantially curtail free enterprise; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Green New Deal would reduce America's future economic growth and  
6 lower the standard of living for millions of Americans; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Green New Deal would not move our nation any closer to reducing  
8 greenhouse gas emissions.
- 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
10 the members of this body urge the United States Congress to oppose the Green New Deal.
- 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
12 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
13 members of the Georgia congressional delegation.
