A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 26-4-80 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 license required for practice of pharmacy, dispensing prescription drugs, prescription drug
- 3 orders, electronically transmitting drug orders, refills, and Schedule II controlled substance
- 4 prescriptions, so as to authorize a pharmacist to dispense up to a 90 day supply of a
- 5 maintenance medication under certain conditions; to provide for exceptions; to provide for
- 6 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 26-4-80 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to license required
- 10 for practice of pharmacy, dispensing prescription drugs, prescription drug orders,
- 11 electronically transmitting drug orders, refills, and Schedule II controlled substance
- 12 prescriptions, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 13 "(q)(1) Unless the prescriber has specified on the prescription that dispensing a
- maintenance medication in an initial amount followed by periodic refills is medically
- 15 <u>necessary, a pharmacist may exercise his or her professional judgment, in consultation</u>
- with the patient, to dispense up to a 90 day supply of medication up to the total number
- of dosage units as authorized by the prescriber on the original prescription, including any
- 18 <u>refills.</u>
- 19 (2) Paragraph (1) of this subsection shall not apply to Schedule II, III, IV, or V controlled
- 20 substances."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
