A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Central Baptist Church on the occasion of its 130th
2 anniversary; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the seeds which were sown by the loving and humble efforts of the devoted
4 original worshipers of what was then Chestnut Baptist Church have blossomed, establishing
5 a rich tradition and history; and

6 WHEREAS, the story of Chestnut Baptist Church is one of triumph through the grace and
7 sustaining power of God, and it stands as an immovable witness to the truth that God keeps
8 His promise; and

9 WHEREAS, the church has been a vital part of the Hall County community, both religiously
10 and historically; and

11 WHEREAS, organized in 1890 under the name of Chestnut Street Mission, the original 15
12 members would congregate in the local schoolhouse that was graciously donated by Miss
13 Amanda McCants; the church was renamed Chestnut Baptist Church in 1891; and

14 WHEREAS, the church was renamed Central Baptist Church following the 1903 tornado that
15 tore across Gainesville, and the work on the current building was completed in 1932 with
16 many of the original features, including a baptismal pool that is one of the oldest baptismal
17 pools in this state and beautiful priceless and irreplaceable stained glass windows; and

18 WHEREAS, the church started with 15 members and currently hosts more than 150; peak
19 attendance occurred in the mid 1900s, when the Sunday school had nearly 1,000 members;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, many of the current members have been life-long members, and the goal of the
22 church is simple: to love others and love Christ; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
24 of peace and love be recognized and congratulated for its innumerable good works rendered
25 on behalf of persons in need.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
27 recognize the rich history of Central Baptist Church, commend its 130 years of dedicated
28 service to the Lord and community, and extend their warmest best wishes for its continued
29 growth and success.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
31 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to Central Baptist
32 Church.
