A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to health, so as to require local boards of education to provide feminine
3 hygiene products in certain restrooms used by students; to provide for a definition; to provide
4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
8 relating to health, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

9 "20-2-779.2.

10 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'feminine hygiene products' means sanitary
11 napkins and tampons.

12 (b) Each local board of education in every school with an enrollment of students in any
13 grade from the sixth through twelfth grade shall provide feminine hygiene products in all
14 female-designated restrooms that are in use for students. Such feminine hygiene products
15 shall be provided at no charge to students."

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
