

## Senate Resolution 688

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Jason Dickerson for his admirable accomplishments with his  
2 Jason T. Dickerson Family Foundation; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Jason Dickerson was born in Canton, Georgia, and has lived in Cherokee  
4 County all of his life. He is currently the chief executive officer of Quest Global Inc. and the  
5 chairman of the Jason T. Dickerson Family Foundation; and

6 WHEREAS, Jason was raised to be a humble man, never to brag or talk about his  
7 accomplishments. When he bought his first company in 2000, he named his brother, Jeremy,  
8 the president and himself the vice president; and

9 WHEREAS, as a determined young man, Jason started his first official job when he was 13  
10 years old as a caddie at a local golf course in Alpharetta, Georgia. By the age of 15,  
11 Dickerson started his first company in 1992, buying and selling large quantities of  
12 automobiles through the wholesale division between Georgia and Florida; and

13 WHEREAS, in 1996, at the age of 20 years, Dickerson started his second company: a  
14 consulting business to show trucking companies how to operate their businesses more  
15 efficiently. Dickerson bought his first company in 2000 at 23 years old and grew the  
16 company from 13 employees with \$1.4 million in annual revenue to 500+ employees with  
17 \$90 million in annual revenue. As of 2019, they were one of the Top 20 Largest Employers  
18 in Bartow County, Georgia; and

19 WHEREAS, since 2015, Dickerson has provided approximately \$2 million of support for  
20 marketing, trailer decals, and parades to bring awareness to United States veterans, in  
21 addition to the delivery of approximately 72,000 wreaths for the Wreaths across America;  
22 and

23 WHEREAS, Dickerson's support for his community extends also to the Toys-for-Tots  
24 program, humane societies, food pantries, foster youth homes, and senior citizen centers  
25 across our state; and

26 WHEREAS, a character like Jason Dickerson is difficult to find, and he sets the standards  
27 high for how to invest back into one's community.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
29 recognize and commend Jason Dickerson for his philanthropic and selfless spirit that will be  
30 felt by communities for decades to come.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
32 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to Jason Dickerson  
33 and his family.
