## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 11, 2020, as NAACP Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, since 1917, the Georgia NAACP has been a worthy instrument for good; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the Georgia NAACP is celebrating 103 years as an advocate for civil and  
4 human rights in the State of Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, this organization under the leadership of Reverend James Woodall has been a  
6 voice for the voiceless, has given hope to the hopeless, and has been a liaison to legislators  
7 as it relates to legislation that is in the best interest of the people. The Georgia NAACP is a  
8 champion for civil and human rights throughout the state, ensuring that the rights and  
9 liberties of all persons in Georgia are guaranteed through the United States Constitution; and
- 10 WHEREAS, its members give of themselves tirelessly and unconditionally to serve our  
11 community through endeavors such as its annual legislative day of action to provide an
