A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 13, 2020, as New Americans Day at the state capitol; and for other
- 2 purposes.

- 3 WHEREAS, on February 13, 2020, more than 300 new Americans, friends, and community
- 4 supporters will visit the state capitol for a day of education and celebration; and

- 5 WHEREAS, Georgia is home to more than one million immigrants who comprise
- 6 approximately 10 percent of the state population and contribute to Georgia's unique culture
- 7 and diversity; and

- 8 WHEREAS, more than 41 percent of Georgia's foreign-born population are naturalized
- 9 United States citizens and eligible voters; and

- 10 WHEREAS, foreign-born Georgians own 31 percent of Georgia's main street businesses,
- 11 despite being only 10 percent of the population, and employ approximately 206,000
- 12 Georgians state wide; and

- 13 WHEREAS, one in seven Georgia workers are foreign-born and play a vital role in the state's
- 14 core industries, including the healthcare industry, where 17 percent of doctors are
- 15 immigrants; and

- 16 WHEREAS, foreign-born Georgians contributed approximately \$8 billion in local, state, and
- 17 federal taxes and held nearly \$22 billion in spending power in 2017 alone; and

- 18 WHEREAS, Georgia is a welcoming home for peoples of all origins and from all walks of
- 19 life, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that these new Americans be appropriately
- 20 recognized.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 recognize February 13, 2020, as New Americans Day at the state capitol and commend the
23 manifold contributions of immigrants to the State of Georgia.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
25 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
26 press.
