## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Dr. Julius Samuel Scott Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of Dr. Julius Samuel Scott Jr. on August  
3 1, 2019; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Dr. Scott was born on February 26, 1925, in Houston, Texas, a beloved son of  
5 Julius S. Scott Sr. and Bertha Bell Scott; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Ann, and was blessed with three  
7 remarkable children, Julius S. Scott III, David, and Lamar; and
- 8 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Dr. Scott was an active member of St. Andrew  
9 By-The-Sea United Methodist Church, where he served in many capacities, including as  
10 Pastor Emeritus; and
- 11 WHEREAS, to devote his life to serving others, Dr. Scott earned degrees in sociology and  
12 religion from Wiley College, Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary, and Brown  
13 University and a doctoral degree in social ethics from Boston University; and
- 14 WHEREAS, his service with numerous organizations, including the Metro Augusta Chamber  
15 of Commerce, the American Cancer Society, the Greater Augusta Arts Council, and the  
16 Savannah River Area Regional Development, is a further testament to his commitment to his  
17 community; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Dr. Scott earned distinction and numerous awards for his community service  
19 and was awarded 14 honorary degrees over the course of his life; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Scott gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep  
21 concern for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he  
22 demonstrated to his family and friends were admired by others; and

23 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
24 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he  
25 made this world a better place in which to live; and

26 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Dr. Scott will long be remembered for his  
27 love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great  
28 fortune of knowing him.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
30 join in honoring the life and memory of Dr. Julius Samuel Scott Jr. and express their deepest  
31 and most sincere regret at his passing.
