A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Jason T. Dickerson for his admirable accomplishments with
2 his Jason T. Dickerson Family Foundation; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Jason T. Dickerson was born in Canton, Georgia, and has lived in Cherokee
4 County all of his life. He is currently the chief executive officer of Quest Global Inc. and the
5 chairman of the Jason T. Dickerson Family Foundation; and

6 WHEREAS, Jason was raised to be a humble man, never to brag about himself or talk about
7 his accomplishments; and

8 WHEREAS, as a determined young man, Jason started his first official job when he was 13
9 years old as a caddie at a local golf course in Alpharetta. By the age of 15, he started his first
10 company in 1992 transporting automobiles between Georgia and Florida; and

11 WHEREAS, in 1996 at the age of 20 years old, Jason T. Dickerson started his second
12 company, a consulting business to show trucking companies how to operate their businesses
13 more efficiently. He bought his third company in 2000 at 23 years old and has grown the
14 company from 13 employees to over 500 employees, and as of 2019, it was the sixth largest
15 employer in Bartow County; and

16 WHEREAS, since 2015, Jason has provided approximately \$2 million of support for
17 marketing, trailer decals, and parades to bring awareness to American veterans, in addition
18 to the delivery of approximately 72,000 wreaths for the annual Wreaths Across America
19 campaign; and

20 WHEREAS, his support for his community extends also to the Toys for Tots program,
21 Humane Societies, food pantries, youth foster homes, and senior citizen centers across our
22 state; and

23 WHEREAS, a character like Jason T. Dickerson is difficult to find, and he sets the standards
24 high for how to invest back into one's community.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
26 recognize and commend Jason T. Dickerson for his philanthropic and selfless spirit that will
27 be felt by communities for decades to come.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
