## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Ms. Betty Ann DiPietro Rappé and rededicating a road on Georgia Ports  
2 Authority property in her honor; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Ms. Betty Ann DiPietro Rappé has long been recognized by the citizens of this  
4 state for the vital role she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the  
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, a graduate of Saint Vincent's Academy, Ms. Rappé began working for the  
7 Georgia Ports Authority in 1967 with the operations division as a clerk-typist; and

8 WHEREAS, during her illustrious career with the Georgia Ports Authority, Ms. Rappé has  
9 held positions as import clerk, import manager, assistant operations administration manager,  
10 operations administration manager, and administration manager in multiple departments; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Rappé's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable  
12 discipline and honesty, her selfless teamwork, and her work ethic and determination have  
13 earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

14 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for  
15 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments and  
17 contributions of this remarkable and distinguished Georgian be recognized appropriately by  
18 dedicating a building in her honor.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
20 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that Directors Drive behind the Annex Buildings at the Garden  
21 City Terminal is rededicated as Rappé Way.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
23 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating Rappé Way to be funded from the  
24 budget of the Georgia Ports Authority.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
26 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Ms.  
27 Betty Ann DiPietro Rappé and to the Department of Transportation and the Georgia Ports  
28 Authority.
