3 to the community and this state and has been recognized as one of the most dynamic and
4 committed organizations in Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, formerly known as The Atlanta Colored Business League, this outstanding
6 organization has had a tremendous impact on its community through its spirit of service and
7 desire to support business owners, professionals, and community leaders in Georgia; and
- 8 WHEREAS, ABL's member businesses represent 50 cities in Georgia and provide 260
9 different products and services; and
- 10 WHEREAS, ABL has had exceptional leadership over the years, including Alice White
11 Bussey, the first female president; Rhonda M. Brown, the first female board chair; and
12 Thomas W. Dortch Jr., the only three-term board chair; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Jesse Blayton, the first black man to pass the CPA exam in Georgia, led the
14 league under the name Black Chamber of Commerce and served as an officer in the National
15 Negro Business League; and
- 16 WHEREAS, ABL has been dedicated to providing unparalleled service and support and
17 remains steadfastly committed to Georgia's businesses and their leaders; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding contributions of this
19 extraordinary organization be appropriately recognized.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the members of this body commend the Atlanta Business League for its many contributions

22 on behalf of the citizens of this state and extend sincere best wishes for future growth and
