10 "(6.1) 'Residential industrialized building' means any dwelling unit designed and 11 constructed in compliance with the Georgia State Minimum Standard One and Two Family Dwelling Code which is wholly or in substantial part made, fabricated, formed, 12 or assembled in a manufacturing facility and cannot be inspected at the installation site 13 14 without disassembly, damage to, or destruction thereof. Any such structure shall may or 15 may not contain a permanent metal chassis and but shall be affixed to a permanent load-bearing foundation. The term shall not include manufactured homes as defined by 16 the National Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Act of 1974, 17 42 U.S.C. Section 5401, et seq." 18
