A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to soil amendments, so as to authorize further regulation of soil amendments derived
- 3 from industrial by-products by local governments; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to soil
- 8 amendments, is amended by revising Code Section 2-12-80, relating to promulgation and
- 9 adoption of rules and regulations and sharing of information, as follows:

- 11 The Commissioner is authorized to promulgate:
- 12 (1) Promulgate and adopt such rules and regulations as may be necessary to enforce this
- article. Such regulations may relate to, but shall not be limited to, methods of inspection
- and examination, designation of ingredients, and identity of products. The Commissioner
- is also authorized to promulgate;
- 16 (2) Promulgate and adopt rules and regulations relative to soil amendments derived from
- industrial by-products which may include, but not be limited to, application rates, proper
- 18 conditions for application, application record keeping and retention, development and use
- of site-specific nutrient management plans, and storage and containment in or on lands
- where soil amendments are applied; provided, however, that such rules and regulations
- 21 <u>shall serve as minimum standards where the governing authority of a county or municipal</u>
- 22 corporation by local ordinance or resolution may further regulate the application of soil
- 23 <u>amendments derived from industrial by-products</u>. The Commissioner is further
- 24 authorized to share; and
