## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending LTC David Titus; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, LTC David Titus retired from the United States Army after 23 years of  
3 honorable service; and
- 4 WHEREAS, even after retirement, he has continued to serve military interests and veterans  
5 through active engagement in veterans' organizations; and
- 6 WHEREAS, LTC Titus played a key role in the planning, designing, funding, and building  
7 of the Vietnam War Memorial at the All Wars Memorial in Augusta, which was completed  
8 in 2019, in time for the 50th anniversary of the Vietnam War; this memorial will provide  
9 current and future generations a historical perspective of the sacrifices that American service  
10 members made in an attempt to stop the spread of communism; and
- 11 WHEREAS, LTC Titus became involved with the Columbia County Republican Party in  
12 1991 when the county was Democrat controlled. Since then, he has been an active member  
13 of the Republican Party, and his steadfast presence and unwavering commitment have long  
14 been cherished; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was elected to the Columbia County Commission in 1992 and served until  
16 1996, finishing his final year as the vice chairman. During his tenure, he identified the need  
17 for a food bank for Columbia County residents and founded Columbia County Cares (CCC);  
18 and
- 19 WHEREAS, LTC Titus' commitment to his community is further evidenced by his  
20 involvement in many community and civic organizations; he has held membership in Sons  
21 of the American Revolution since 1957 and is an active member of Columbia County West  
22 Rotary Club; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
24 extraordinary citizen be appropriately recognized.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
26 the members of this body recognize and commend LTC David Titus for his efficient,  
27 effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the State of Georgia and extend the most  
28 sincere best wishes for continued health and happiness.
