A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Randy Redner; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Randy Redner has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital
3 role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the
4 citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state, as evidenced
7 dramatically by his superlative service with the Community Foundation for Northeast
8 Georgia since 2005; and

10 has held monthly education events, added \$1.4 million to the Good2Give Community Fund,
