A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Georgia Cattlemen's Association for uniting and advancing Georgia's cattle
2 industry; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, March 11, 2020, is Georgia Cattlemen's Association Day at the state capitol;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the Georgia Cattlemen's were founded and established in 1961; and

6 WHEREAS, the Georgia Cattlemen's have grown to 65 local chapters with more than 5,500
7 members around the state; and

8 WHEREAS, they are led by their President, Brent Galloway of Lyons, Georgia, in Toombs
9 County; and

10 WHEREAS, the cattle industry has a \$1 billion farm gate value in the State of Georgia; and

11 WHEREAS, the cattle industry has a \$4 billion economic impact in the State of Georgia; and

12 WHEREAS, there are 15,000 cattle producers in the State of Georgia; and

13 WHEREAS, there are cattle being produced in every county in the State of Georgia.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 recognize the Georgia Cattlemen's Association for uniting and advancing Georgia's cattle
16 industry.
