1 Recognizing and commending Professor Carlos B. Brown; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Professor Carlos B. Brown has a long and consistent record of service to the
3 performing arts community and this state and has been recognized as one of the most
4 dynamic maestros in the country; and

5 WHEREAS, a native of Atlanta, Georgia, Professor Brown currently serves as assistant
6 professor of music and director of choral activities at Central State University in Ohio, where
7 he conducts the Central State University Chorus and The Marauder Singers; and

8 WHEREAS, he is the founder and artistic director of the Angelic Master Chorale, a small
9 chamber choral ensemble dedicated to the performance and preservation of African
10 American choral music and European classical music; Professor Brown also serves as
11 artist-in-residence with the Loretta Mangrum Chorale in Cincinnati, Ohio; and

12 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentleman has diligently and conscientiously devoted
13 innumerable hours of his time, talents, and energy to the study and practice of choral music,
14 and his conducting is highly regarded for being passionate, captivating, technical, and
15 gorgeous; and

16 WHEREAS, Professor Brown is a member of many professional music organizations such
17 as the National Association of Negro Musicians Inc., Chorus America, American Choral
18 Conductors Association, Conductors Guild, and Ohio Choral Directors Association; and

19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
20 extraordinary individual be appropriately honored.
