## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Carl Evans and dedicating an intersection in his memory; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put  
4 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the  
5 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Evans served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the  
7 United States military, valiantly and courageously defending democracy during World War I;  
8 and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Evans demonstrated selfless service to this nation and an unyielding  
10 commitment to protecting the people and ideals of the United States; and

11 WHEREAS, he embodied the spirit of service, willing to find meaning in something greater  
12 than himself; and

13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
14 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in his memory.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
16 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 1 and Veterans Memorial  
17 Highway in Floyd County is dedicated as the Carl Evans Memorial Intersection.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
19 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Carl Evans Memorial  
20 Intersection.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
22 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
23 family of Mr. Carl Evans and to the Department of Transportation.
