## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Employees' Retirement System of Georgia, so as to provide that certain employees who are
- 3 required to be members of the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia and who were
- 4 former members of the Teachers Retirement System of Georgia with at least nine years,
- 5 seven months, and 30 days of membership service may elect to remain members of the
- 6 Teachers Retirement System of Georgia; to provide for related matters; to provide conditions
- 7 for an effective date and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Chapter 2 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Employees'
- 11 Retirement System of Georgia, is amended by revising paragraph (1) of subsection (c) of
- 12 Code Section 47-2-181, relating to transfer of service credits and accumulated contributions
- 13 from the Teachers Retirement System of Georgia to the Employees' Retirement System of
- 14 Georgia, as follows:
- 15 "(c)(1) Any provision of this title to the contrary notwithstanding, any vested member
- of the Teachers Retirement System and any person with at least nine years, seven
- months, and 30 days of membership service in the Teachers Retirement System who
- becomes an employee of an employer may, at his or her option, elect to remain a
- member of the Teachers Retirement System of Georgia."
- 20 SECTION 2.
- 21 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2020, only if it is determined to have been
- 22 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 23 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not
- 24 become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2020, as
- required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.
