A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide that future elections for the office of probate judge of Berrien County shall be
- 2 nonpartisan elections; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 3 purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 All elections for the office of probate judge of Berrien County conducted after the effective
- 7 date of this Act shall be nonpartisan elections as provided for in Code Section 21-2-139 of
- 8 the O.C.G.A. Such nonpartisan elections shall be conducted at the general nonpartisan
- 9 election immediately preceding the expiration of the term of such office and conducted as
- provided in Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code."

SECTION 2.

- 12 Nothing in this Act shall affect the term of office of the probate judge of Berrien County in
- office on the effective date of this Act. The sitting probate judge shall serve out the term of
- 14 office for which he or she was elected and shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself as
- 15 provided in this Act.

SECTION 3.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
