## A RESOLUTION

13 NewLife Radio continues to serve thousands of listeners from the south metro Atlanta,

15 WHEREAS, NewLife Radio continues to broadcast its heartwarming and life-changing  
16 programming 24 hours each day to the citizens of Georgia; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
18 extraordinary company be appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
20 congratulate and commend NewLife Radio upon the grand occasion of its 25th anniversary  
21 and extend best wishes for many more years of successful broadcasting.
