## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 26, 2021, as City of Tucker Councilman Bill Rosenfeld Day; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
4 with the passing of City of Tucker Councilman Bill Rosenfeld; and

5 WHEREAS, Bill committed his life in service to his community, beginning with his service  
6 as a volunteer in the Fire Rescue Squad for Guilford County EMS; and

7 WHEREAS, throughout his life, he improved the quality of life for those around him, as  
8 demonstrated by his role in the extension and development of emergency services in  
9 McDowell County, North Carolina, and later as the director of McDowell County EMS; and

10 WHEREAS, he further dedicated innumerable hours as a paramedic with DeKalb County  
11 EMS and advocated for other small businesses in Tucker, Georgia, after he positioned  
12 himself as a successful businessman within the community; and

13 WHEREAS, as a Tucker City councilman, he was passionate about the city's development  
14 and progress, working diligently to improve living conditions for the residents of Smoke

15 Rise, including resurfacing the roads, revamping parks and recreation areas, and renovating  
16 the Peters Park neighborhood; and

17 WHEREAS, he was further active in the community through his service to the Tucker Rotary  
18 Club, his work on the Board of Directors for Tucker-Northlake CID, and his generous  
19 support of local charities in the Smoke Rise community; and

20 WHEREAS, Bill gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
21 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
22 family and friends were admired by others; and

23 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
24 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he  
25 made this world a better place in which to live; and

26 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, remarkable patience and  
27 diplomacy, keen sense of vision, and sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this state  
28 earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

29 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
30 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
32 the members of this body recognize February 26, 2021, as City of Tucker Councilman Bill  
33 Rosenfeld Day and express their regret at his passing.
