A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Georgia Craft Brewers Guild and recognizing March 6, 2021, as Georgia
2 Beer Day; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Georgia Beer Day is celebrated annually in breweries and brewpubs by craft
4 brewers and beer enthusiasts statewide; and

5 WHEREAS, craft brewers are among the finest examples of entrepreneurship and innovation
6 in Georgia, operating as community-based small businesses; and

7 WHEREAS, the craft beer industry had a \$1.8 billion impact on Georgia's economy in 2019
8 and created over 12,000 jobs; and

9 WHEREAS, there are over 100 craft breweries across Georgia that serve as anchors of
10 development and catalysts of growth in local communities; and

11 WHEREAS, these small businesses support local neighborhoods, drive tourism, and play a
12 vital role in Georgia's hospitality industry; and

13 WHEREAS, craft breweries provide a family-friendly environment, promote responsible
14 consumption, and serve as a gathering spot in neighborhoods; and

15 WHEREAS, craft beer from Georgia is consistently recognized nationally and internationally
16 for being among the finest, winning awards for quality and taste; and

17 WHEREAS, the Georgia Craft Brewers Guild serves as the voice for advocacy, education,
18 and awareness for the growing craft beer industry across the state.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend the Georgia Craft Brewers Guild for its contributions to the craft beer industry in
21 the State of Georgia and recognize March 6, 2021, as Georgia Beer Day.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
