## A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating and commending Dr. Monica Parker for receiving the 2021 Nikki T. Randall  
2 Servant Leader Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in 1999, Representative Nikki T. Randall became the first African American  
4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of  
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia  
6 Legislative Women's Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Legislative Women's  
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and  
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. Monica Parker has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable  
11 hours of her time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state, as  
12 evidenced by her many years of superlative service in the medical profession, including as  
13 a geriatric and primary care provider and as a clinical research investigator; and

14 WHEREAS, Dr. Parker leads the Minority Engagement Core (MEC) at the Emory Goizueta  
15 Alzheimer's Disease Research Center, where she advocates and educates about Alzheimer's

16 disease, care giving resources, and the importance of research participation to eliminate  
17 health disparities in persons of color; and

18 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentlewoman has the great honor of serving with several civic  
19 and professional organizations, and she is a recipient of multiple prestigious awards,  
20 including the Wesley Woods Foundation's A Key to A Cure Award and *Atlanta Magazine's*  
21 Groundbreaker of the Year Award; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Parker has established a glowing reputation of renown throughout Georgia  
23 for her expertise and dedication to excellence, exhibiting a deep personal commitment to the  
24 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
26 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
