A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the office of commissioner of Catoosa County, approved
2 February 12, 1943 (Ga. L. 1943, p. 858), as amended, particularly by an Act approved
3 February 6, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 4501), so as to revise provisions regarding the
4 compensation of the governing authority; to repeal provisions requiring the governing
5 authority to maintain offices at the county courthouse; revise provisions relating to meetings
6 of the governing authority; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
7 other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 An Act creating the office of commissioner of Catoosa County, approved February 12, 1943
11 (Ga. L. 1943, p. 858), as amended, particularly by an Act approved February 6, 1992
12 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 4501), is amended by revising Section 9A as follows:

13 "SECTION 9A.

14 (a) Each member of the Board of Commissioners of Catoosa County, except the
15 chairperson, shall receive an annual base salary of \$12,000.00 to be paid in equal monthly

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16 installments from the funds of Catoosa County. The chairperson of the board of
17 commissioners shall receive an annual base salary of \$16,000.00 to be paid in equal
18 monthly installments from the funds of Catoosa County.

19 (b) The compensations provided for in subsection (a) of this section shall be adjusted on
20 January 1 of each year based on the change in the Consumer Price Index for all urban
21 consumers of the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor.

22 (c) The chairperson and members of the board of commissioners shall also be reimbursed
23 by the county for actual expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties.

24 (d) The board of commissioners shall meet for a regular meeting on the first Tuesday of
25 every month at a place to be designated in advance by the board. The board shall have the
26 right to hold special meetings when, in its discretion, the business of the county may
27 require. Special meetings shall be called by the chairperson or by a majority of the board,
28 provided that each board member and the legal organ of the county is given at least 24
29 hours advance notice of such special meeting. Three members of the board shall constitute
30 a quorum of the board of commissioners."

31 **SECTION 2.**

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
