

**ADOPTED**

Senators Parent of the 42nd, Jones of the 10th and Butler of the 55th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend SB 293 (LC 47 0995) by inserting after "Decatur;" on line 8 the following:*  
2 to provide for contingent repeal of provisions;

3 *By inserting after line 96 the following:*

4 (7) Paragraphs (2) through (6) of this subsection shall stand repealed on July 1, 2026, if:

5 (A) The City Schools of Decatur's allocation of the City of Decatur school tax does not  
6 equal at least 75 percent of the local share costs of educating those students who enroll  
7 due to annexations and cause the number of students enrolled in the City Schools of  
8 Decatur to increase by 5 percent or more from the total enrollment prior to July 1, 2021;

9 or

10 (B) The DeKalb County school system's allocation of the City Schools of Decatur  
11 school tax does not equal at least 50 percent of the taxes it would have received from  
12 property annexed by the City of Decatur after July 1, 2021, if such property had  
13 remained in unincorporated DeKalb County.
