

The Senate Committee on Government Oversight offered the following substitute to HB 92:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 31-10-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 disclosure of information contained in vital records and transfer of records to State Archives,
3 so as to revise provisions regarding the transfer of vital records to State Archives; to provide
4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 31-10-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to disclosure of
8 information contained in vital records and transfer of records to State Archives, is amended
9 by revising subsection (e) as follows:

10 "(e) When 125 years have elapsed after the date of birth or ~~100~~ 75 years have elapsed after
11 the date of death or application for marriage, or divorce, dissolution of marriage, or
12 annulment, the records of these events in the custody of the state registrar shall be
13 transferred to the State Archives and such information shall be made available in
14 accordance with regulations which shall provide for the continued safekeeping of the
15 records."

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
