- 11 WHEREAS, a young man of deep and abiding faith, Tyler was an active member of
12 Fishermen Inc., a nonprofit Christian ministry in Valdosta, Georgia; and

13 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
14 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
15 family and friends were admired by others; and

16 WHEREAS, Tyler was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable
17 reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of
18 his life, he made this world a better place in which to live; and

19 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous young man, Tyler Maier Studstill will long be
20 remembered for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who
21 had the great fortune of knowing him.
