A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Myrtle Mayfield; and for other purposes.

4 of the citizens of Georgia; and

21 WHEREAS, Myrtle has served with honor and distinction with the NCNW DeKalb Section,
22 and her vision and unyielding commitment to helping people in need have set the standard
23 for civic service; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
25 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
27 recognize and commend Myrtle Mayfield for her efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated
28 service to the State of Georgia and extend the most sincere best wishes for continued health
