

House Bill 1017

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act relating to the Montgomery County Board of Education, approved
2 March 21, 1979 (Ga. L. 1979, p. 3151), as amended, particularly by an Act approved
3 March 20, 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, p. 4489), so as to change the description of the education
4 districts; to provide for the manner of election; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to
5 provide for the continuation in office of current members; to provide for initial terms of
6 office; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 An Act relating to the Montgomery County Board of Education, approved March 21, 1979
10 (Ga. L. 1979, p. 3151), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 20, 2012 (Ga.
11 L. 2012, p. 4489), is amended by revising Section 1 of Article II as follows:

12 "SECTION 1.

13 (a) For purposes of electing members of the board, the Montgomery County School
14 District is divided into five education districts, and those districts shall be and correspond
15 to those five districts described in Appendix A attached to and made a part of this Act and

16 further identified as 'User: Montgomery Co. Plan Name: montgomeryccsb-2022 Plan Type:
17 Local'.

18 (b)(1) For the purposes of such plan:

19 (A) The term 'VTD' shall mean and describe the same geographical boundaries as
20 provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial
21 census of 2020 for the State of Georgia. The separate numeric designations in a district
22 description which are underneath a VTD heading shall mean and describe individual
23 Blocks within a VTD as provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the
24 United States decennial census of 2020 for the State of Georgia; and

25 (B) Except as otherwise provided in the description of any district, whenever the
26 description of any district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical
27 boundaries of that city as shown on the census maps for the United States decennial
28 census of 2020 for the State of Georgia.

29 (2) Any part of the Montgomery County School District which is not included in any
30 district described in subsection (a) of this section shall be included within that district
31 contiguous to such part which contains the least population according to the United States
32 decennial census of 2020 for the State of Georgia.

33 (3) Any part of the Montgomery County School District which is described in
34 subsection (a) of this section as being included in a particular district shall nevertheless
35 not be included within such district if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such
36 noncontiguous part shall instead be included within that district contiguous to such part
37 which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census
38 of 2020 for the State of Georgia."

39 **SECTION 2.**

40 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 2 of Article II as follows:

41 "SECTION 2.

42 (a) One member shall be elected from each district by the electors of such districts.

43 (b) Any person qualifying as a candidate shall designate the education district for which
44 he or she desires to qualify. A person shall not offer as a candidate for election to the board
45 from any education district other than the education district in which he or she is a legal
46 resident."

47 **SECTION 3.**

48 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 4 of Article II as follows:

49 "SECTION 4.

50 (a) Those members of the Board of Education of Montgomery County who are serving as
51 such on the effective date of this section and any person selected to fill a vacancy in any
52 such office shall continue to serve as such members until the regular expiration of their
53 respective terms of office and upon the election and qualification of their respective
54 successors.

55 (b) On the effective date of this section, the member of the board of education representing
56 former Education District 1 shall be deemed to represent new Education District 1, the
57 member of the board of education representing former Education District 2 shall be deemed
58 to represent new Education District 2, the member of the board of education representing
59 former Education District 3 Post 1 shall be deemed to represent new Education District 4,
60 the member of the board of education representing former Education District 3 Post 2 shall
61 be deemed to represent new Education District 3, and the member of the board of education
62 representing former Education District 4 shall be deemed to represent new Education
63 District 5.

64 (c)(1) At the general election in 2022, a successor shall be elected to the member
65 representing new Education District 5. Such successor shall take office on January 1

66 following such election for a term of four years and until his or her successor is elected
67 and qualified.

68 (2) At the general election in 2022, a successor shall be elected to the member
69 representing new Education District 3. Such successor shall take office on January 1
70 following such election for a term of two years and until his or her successor is elected
71 and qualified.

72 (3) At the general election in 2024, successors shall be elected to the members
73 representing new Education District Districts 1 and 2. Such successors shall take office
74 on January 1 following such election for a term of four years and until their respective
75 successors are elected and qualified.

76 (4) At the general election in 2024, a successor shall be elected to the member
77 representing new Education District 4. Such successor shall take office on January 1
78 following such election for a term of two years and until his or her successor is elected
79 and qualified.

80 (d) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, successors to all members shall be
81 elected to terms of four years and until their respective successors are elected and qualified.
82 Successors shall be elected in the general election in the year in which their respective
83 terms of office expire and shall take office on the first day of January immediately
84 following their election."

85 **SECTION 4.**

86 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
