A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Billy Reed; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Billy Reed has for many years served the people of the communities in which
3 he has lived and worked, and he has served the people of Georgia as an upstanding citizen,
4 a volunteer in politics, a business owner and leader, and a servant within his churches; and

5 WHEREAS, Reed served as the manager of the Gainesville office of the Georgia Department
6 of Labor for eight years as well as provided marketing and promotional services as the owner
7 of Billy Reed Advertising for 10 years; and

8 WHEREAS, Reed provided many hours of community service over five years as a member
9 of the Lions Club of Gainesville, an organization dedicated to fostering understanding among
10 peoples and promoting community service and good citizenship with no thought of personal
11 financial reward; and

12 WHEREAS, Reed has sought over many years to promote and advance the principles of
13 conservatism and good government by serving as a volunteer on the campaigns of numerous
14 Republican candidates for elected office; and

15 WHEREAS, Reed has also fostered faith in his family and community as a devoted member
16 of the churches in the communities in which he has lived, including as a member of the First
17 Baptist Church of Atlanta under Dr. Charles Stanley; and

18 WHEREAS, Reed has been faithful in his most important roles as husband of 52 years to his
19 wife, Suzanne, and father to his sons, David and Kelley; and

20 WHEREAS, by the example Reed has made of his life, he has made this world a better place
21 in which to live, and it is only fitting and proper that he be appropriately honored.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 recognize and commend Billy Reed for his many years of faithful service to his family, to
24 the communities in which he has lived, and the people of Georgia; in doing so, he has been
25 an example of selfless service and good citizenship.
