1 Recognizing and commending Mission Agape; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mission Agape has a long and consistent record of service to the community
3 and this state and has been recognized as one of the most dynamic and committed civic
4 organizations in Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, this outstanding organization has had a tremendous impact on its community
6 through its spirit of service and desire to improve the quality of life in the Atlanta area and
7 around the world; and

8 WHEREAS, this remarkable civic organization has established a glowing reputation of
9 renown throughout Georgia for its dedication and high ideals; and

10 WHEREAS, this independent Christian charity started in 2008 and, prior to the pandemic,
11 provided between 30,000 and 40,000 hot nutritious meals per year; and

12 WHEREAS, during the fall, Mission Agape focuses its fundraising efforts to purchase and
13 distribute between 500 and 750 new winter coats to those in need in Atlanta; and

14 WHEREAS, Mission Agape supports sister missions in South Korea and Peru, where
15 medical supplies and financial support have been sent along with volunteers; and

16 WHEREAS, Mission Agape has been dedicated to providing unparalleled service and
17 support and remains steadfastly committed to the principles of skill, integrity, and
18 responsibility; and

19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
20 extraordinary organization be appropriately recognized.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body recognize and commend Mission Agape for helping Atlanta's
23 homeless and financially fragile and extend best wishes for the future.
