A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To authorize the governing authority of Forsyth County to levy an excise tax pursuant to
- 2 subsection (b) of Code Section 48-13-51 of the O.C.G.A.; to provide for procedures,
- 3 conditions, and limitations; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to
- 4 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 At the request of the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to the authority of
- 8 subsection (b) of Code Section 48-13-51 of the O.C.G.A., the governing authority of Forsyth
- 9 County is hereby authorized to increase and levy an excise tax at a rate not to exceed 8
- 10 percent of the charge for the furnishing for value to the public of any room or rooms,
- 11 lodgings, or accommodations furnished by any person or legal entity licensed by, or required
- 12 to pay business or occupation taxes to, the county for operating a hotel, motel, inn, lodge,
- 13 tourist camp, tourist cabin, campground, or any other place in which rooms, lodgings, or
- 14 accommodations are regularly or periodically furnished for value.

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15 SECTION 2.

16 The enactment of this Act is subsequent to the adoption of a resolution by the governing

- 17 authority of Forsyth County on February 22, 2022, which specifies the subsequent tax rate,
- 18 identifies the projects or tourism product development purposes, and specifies the allocation
- 19 of proceeds.

SECTION 3.

- 21 In accordance with the terms of such resolution adopted by the governing authority of
- 22 Forsyth County:
- 23 (1) In each fiscal year during which a tax is collected pursuant to paragraph (3) of
- subsection (b) of Code Section 48-13-51 of the O.C.G.A., an amount equal to not less
- 25 than 50 percent of the total amount of taxes collected that exceeds the amount of taxes
- 26 that would be collected at the rate of 5 percent shall be expended for promoting tourism,
- conventions, and trade shows by the destination marketing organization designated by
- Forsyth County or by such other entity already authorized to administer tourism funds
- pursuant to an existing contract as specified in paragraph (2) of subsection (e) of Code
- 30 Section 48-13-51 of the O.C.G.A.; and
- 31 (2) The remaining amount of taxes collected that exceeds the amount of taxes that would
- be collected at the rate of 5 percent which is not otherwise expended under paragraph (1)
- of this section shall be expended for tourism product development.
- SECTION 4.
- 35 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 36 without such approval.
- SECTION 5.
- 38 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
