## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
controlled substances, so as to provide that mitragynine and hydroxymitragynine are
Schedule I controlled substances; to repeal provisions relating to the regulation of kratom;
to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
7	Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to controlled
8	substances, is amended in Code Section 16-13-25, relating to Schedule I, by substituting a
9	semicolon for the period at the end of subparagraph (E) of paragraph (16) and by adding a
10	new paragraph to read as follows:
11	"(17) Any material, compound, mixture, or preparation which contains any quantity of
12	mitragynine or hydroxymitragynine, including their salts, isomers, optical isomers, salts
13	of their isomers, and salts of these optical isomers."
14	<b>SECTION 2.</b>
15	Said chapter is further amended by repealing Article 6, relating to kratom, in its entirety.
