A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Professional Association of Georgia Educators (PAGE) and recognizing
2 February 21, 2023, as PAGE Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, PAGE is the state's largest organization for professional educators with more
4 than 95,000 members who are teachers, administrators, and support personnel employed in
5 every school system in Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, PAGE was founded in the 1970s with the mission to make Georgia a better
7 place for students to learn and for teachers to teach; and

8 WHEREAS, the PAGE Foundation sponsors the Academic Bowl for middle grades, the
9 Georgia Academic Decathlon for high school students, and the Student and Teacher
10 Achievement Recognition (STAR) program; and

11 WHEREAS, PAGE has promoted teaching as a profession by sponsoring local chapters of
12 the Future Georgia Educators in middle and high schools across the state; and

13 WHEREAS, PAGE provides legal protection and professional learning to enhance
14 competence and confidence, build leadership, and increase student achievement; and

15 WHEREAS, PAGE actively participates in the legislative process each year, working to
16 improve education and student achievement; and

17 WHEREAS, on February 21, 2023, PAGE members and leaders will gather at the state
18 capitol to meet with their local legislators.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend the Professional Association of Georgia Educators (PAGE) for its advocacy and
21 support of educators and education and recognize February 21, 2023, as PAGE Day at the
22 state capitol.
